# GNOME BUNNY



### **MATERIALS**

MB1571 Lars Gnome
Detail Brush
Medium Brush
Water Based Marker
Small Sponge Dotter
Sponge

## **COLORS**

CMM 58 - Beach Comber

CMM 55- Sea Mist
CMM 67 - Snowflake
CMM 16 - Chiffon
CMM 101 - Fresh Heather
CMM 93 - London Fog
CMM 76 - Lemon Mist
CMM 69 - Carrot Juice
CMM 27 - Kiwi
CMM 44 - Battleship



#### INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Paint the beard with 2 coats of London Fog.
- 2. Dip your sponge in water and squeeze it out. Sweep the sponge across the beard to wipe off the grey paint on the top. When you're done there should only be paint in the grooves.
- 3. Use a marker to draw bunny ears on the hat.
- 4. Take a detail brush and paint the outside of the ears with 2 coats of Snowflake.
- 5. Paint the inside part of the ears with 3 coats of Chiffon.
- 6. Use a detail brush to paint in the nose and hands with 3 coats of Beachcomber.
- 7. Paint the hat, working around the bunny ears, with 3 coats of Sea Mist.
- 8. Paint the clothes with 3 coats of Fresh Heather.
- 9. Dip the sponge dabber into Lemon Mist and tap off the excess. Stamp the dots onto the hat, repeat for a second coat.
- 10. Use a detail brush to paint a carrot under the hand with 3 caots of Carrot Juice.
- 11. Tap in 2 coats of Kiwi to make the greens on the carrots.
- 12. Finally use a detail brush with Battleship to outline the ears and the carrot.

#### **TIPS**

- When using a detail brush, the harder you press on the brush the heavier the lines will be.
- If you want your dots to be the same size, dip it into paint after each dot. Otherwise they'll get progressively smaller.
